

Helping Crime Victims: A Training on Crime Victims' Rights and Compensation

The Wisconsin Department of Justice Office of Crime Victim Services (OCVS) is offering training on crime victim compensation and the enforcement of crime victims' rights in Wisconsin. Professionals assisting victims of crime are encouraged to attend.

Participants will learn about the assistance that the Crime Victim Compensation Program provides to victims, the application process, the assessment of eligibility, compensable crimes, and the financial assistance that can be provided.

This training will also focus on the rights and services that crime victims are eligible to receive, the role of the Department of Justice to carry out the informal process authorized by law to remedy potential violations of crime victims' rights, and how to assist crime victims when enforcing their rights at the local level.

This training will fulfill the requirement for positions funded by the Victims of Crime Act (VOCA) and Sexual Assault Victim Services (SAVS) grants. VOCA and/or SAVS funded positions are only required to attend one OCVS sponsored training and are not required to attend each year. People who arrive late or leave early will not receive credit.
