This letter will assist you in budgeting for TIME System fees for next year. The TIME System Advisory Committee voted on April 19<sup>th</sup>, 2011 for no change in the below rates for 2012:

Full Service & MDT Access	\$50/month	no change
eTIME Access Only (Traditional *)	\$50/month	no change
eTIME Access Only (Non-Traditional)	\$100/month	no change
Non-Traditional	\$100/month	no change
Department of Corrections	\$6,000/month	no change
District Attorneys	\$6,000/month	no change
