STODDARD WOMEN SENTENCED TO 60 MONTHS ON METHAMPHETAMINE CHARGE

Madison, Wis. - John W. Vaudreuil, United States Attorney for the Western District of Wisconsin, announced that Angela Davis, 33, Stoddard, Wis., was sentenced today by U.S. District Judge Barbara B. Crabb to 60 months for conspiracy to possess pseudoephedrine with the intent to manufacture methamphetamine. Davis pleaded guilty to this charge on February 8, 2011.

On September 29, 2010, Davis was arrested after law enforcement officers executed a search warrant at an apartment adjacent to a supper club in Vernon County, Wis.. Officers seized components to manufacture methamphetamine along with an active methamphetamine lab. Davis's co-defendant Chris Polus was also arrested and is scheduled to be sentenced on May 2, 2011.

The charges against Davis were the result of an investigation conducted by the Vernon County Sheriff's Department, La Crosse County Sheriff's Department, and Wisconsin Department of Justice, Division of Criminal Investigation. The prosecution of the case has been handled by Assistant U.S. Attorney Paul W. Connell.
