### **AG Schimel Responds to Court's Decision in *Whitford v. Gill***

MADISON, Wis. – Today, a three-judge panel sitting in the United States District Court for the Western District of Wisconsin issued a decision in *Whitford v. Gill*, Wisconsin's redistricting case. Two of the judges found for the plaintiffs but did not provide any remedy and directed the parties to file briefs within 30 days to address the remedial portion of the case. United States District Judge William Griesbach dissented.

“The Department of Justice is evaluating the court's 159-page decision and we plan to appeal,” said Attorney General Brad Schimel. “This 2-1 decision does not affect the results of this month's election or any prior election and legislative district boundaries remain unchanged until the court rules on any remedy.”
