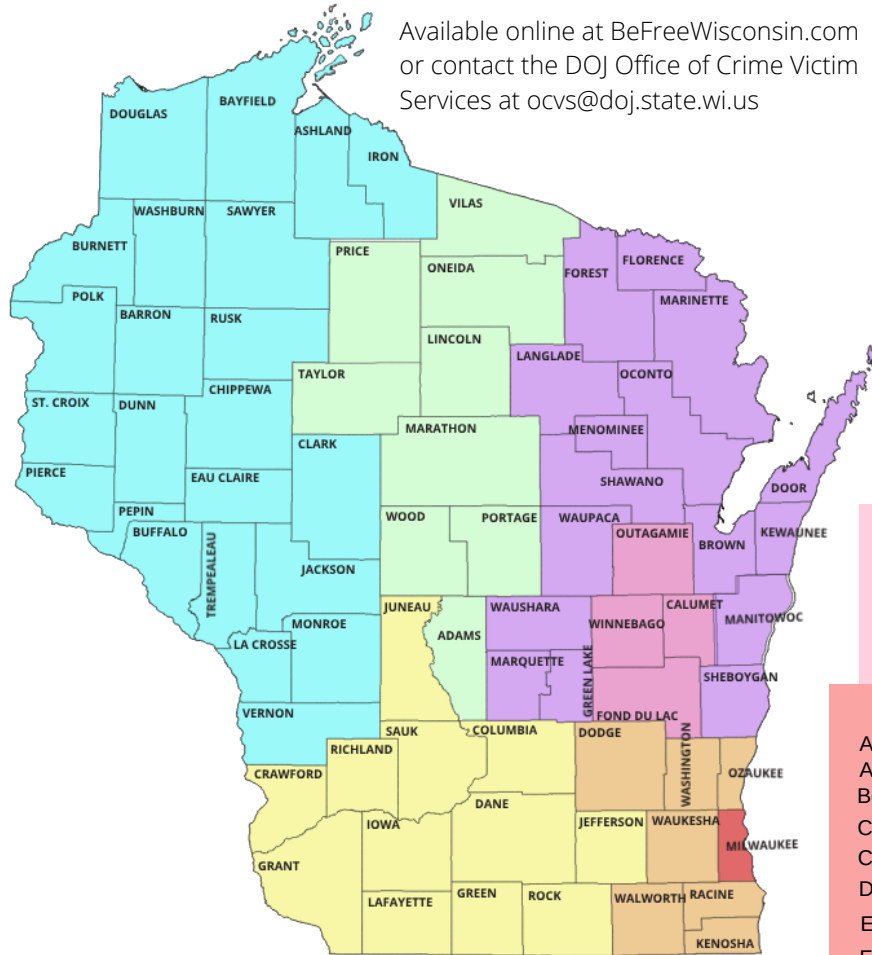

USE & LIMITATIONS

This resource was created to provide a solid starting point for finding local resources for individuals who have been trafficked. Most (but not all) have 24/7 hotlines staffed by people ready to respond to crisis situations, to assist people dealing with trauma and to help identify local resources to meet needs. All provide direct services and are prepared to offer information and ideas that can be of assistance to people who have been trafficked. All have agreed to be listed in this resource for that purpose.

Some listed agencies have specific staff who focus on human trafficking or staff with specialized training. Others serve HT victims with a variety of needs without necessarily identifying themselves as “human trafficking services.”

Help victims connect to services without forwarding a victim's personal or identifying information, unless you have the individual's permission to do so. When calling, it is recommended you ask how to best connect someone to a resource. Agencies may require verbal or written consent before talking about a specific person. Some agencies require talking directly with a potential client for specific information on available programs. All listed agencies will offer information and resources about what an agency does. It is highly recommended that those who work with victims reach out BEFORE they are in need of a victim service organization in order to develop strong relationships with providers in their area.

Please Note: Organizations that provide strictly education and awareness services are not included in this resource. Listed organizations are not vetted or endorsed by the Wisconsin Department of Justice. The best guide is your firsthand experience with providers over time.
