

Wisconsin Crime Victims' Rights Board
Case Statistics Summary
Updated December 2018

- **Cases:** The Board has received 70 cases since becoming operational in 1999.
- **Respondents:** 33% of complaints filed named more than type of respondent.

Prosecutor	63% / 44
Law Enforcement	40% / 28
Judge	21% / 15
Other County or State Agency	20% / 14
County Victim Witness Office	11% / 8

- **Probable Cause:** Complaints often contain more than one allegation. The Board makes a probable cause decision on each allegation contained in a complaint.

Probable cause was found to exist with regard to at least one allegation in 57% of complaints filed.*

At least one allegation was dismissed for lack of probable cause in 36 % of complaints filed.*

- **Investigations & Hearings:**

The Board has conducted 34 investigations.
The Board has held 13 evidentiary hearings.

- **Remedies:**

The Board sought equitable relief on behalf of a victim in 2 cases.
13 private reprimands issued.
33 Reports and Recommendations issued.
2 Special Reports issued concerning the securing and provision of victim rights and services.

- **Judicial Appeals:**

2 cases reversed on appeal
2 cases affirmed on appeal
1 appeal pending
