

## Sexual Assault Victim Services (SAVS) FAQ's

1. We have been level-funded for many years. I have no idea what the projected SAVS funding looks like in the next few years. Do you think it's reasonable to increase our funding request?

Current SAVS Funding above the \$2 million GPR funds, are funds received from the Child Pornography Surcharge. As they are surcharge funds, they are difficult to project. Applicants may increase their current budget, but DOJ reserves the right to adjust any budget requests.

2. Just for clarification, please, the announcement states, "... the organization does not receive more than 70% of its operating budget from grants under this section."

That means that our agency's SAVS funding is not more than 70% of our operating budget vs.

our agency's operating budget is not more than 70% grants overall

SAVS Funds do not comprise more than 70% of your operating budget.

3. In the Additional Personnel Budget Summary:

For each employee -do we list the entire cost of the position including the fringe?

Then in the budget, does each position have to equal the same amount as above minus the fringe? We allow 9.5% for fica, uc, wc. Which would be itemized per position.

Additional Personnel Budget Summary-SAVS: List Annual Salary without fringe.

Budget: Personnel = Annual Salary-Same as Additional Personnel Budget Summary-SAVS (without fringe)

Employee Benefits = FICA, WC, UC, etc., -See example in funding announcement for calculations.

4. Should the grant be single or double spaced? It seems relevant for the section(s) with page limits.
