Synopsis

On Wednesday, June 22, 2017 the jury in State vs. Dominique Heaggan-Brown returned a verdict of not guilty for the charge of First Degree Reckless Homicide. All of the evidence entered in this case was returned to SAC Klabunde and placed back on inventory at the DCI Milwaukee field office.

On Monday, June 12, 2017, a Jury Trial for former Milwaukee Police Officer Dominique Heaggan-Brown commenced in the Circuit Court of Milwaukee SB502 before the honorable Judge Jeffrey Conen. A jury was selected and testimony began on Wednesday, June 14, 2017. Testimony continued through Tuesday morning on Jun3 20, 2017 when the case went to the jury for deliberations. On Wednesday, June 21, 2017 in the afternoon, the jury returned a verdict of not guilty to charge of First Degree Reckless Homicide. Therefore, Dominique Heaggan-Brown was acquitted of the charges.

On Wednesday, June 21, 2017 after the jury finding of not guilty in this case, the prosecutor made a motion to the court to release all of the evidence that had been entered during the trial back to DCI. This case file can be closed as the prosecution has been concluded with the verdict of not guilty.
